# Campus Spotlight:

## Meet Shanikya, Lucy and Haliyah

Haliyah gives a big, welcoming wave as you approach the front door of Maggie's Place. She's all smiles as she runs up to introduce herself and shake your hand. She giggles as the handshake becomes high fives, and then she gives you a big hug. Older sister Lucy is watching, laughing as she runs up to share the high fives and hugs. While she is all smiles, she is a little more reserved than Haliyah, not quite ready for conversation.

The Hubbards have been part of the HomePlace Ministry for about seven months. Mom Shanikya says it has been such a blessing after years of moving from place to place. She and her little ones stayed with different relatives and friends for the past few years. She has always tried to work to support her family. Their moves often put them in situations where there was a lack of transportation which created challenges in getting back and forth to work. Her sister told her about LBCH and HomePlace. Once Shanikya did some research, she knew there was hope for her and her little ones. After connecting with Susan Clark, Director of Family Care Ministries, things moved quickly, and the family was soon settled into Grace Cottage, later transitioning to Maggie's Place.

Shanikya says the move to the LBCH Campus was an easy one. The girls had a few nights of waking up and wondering where they were. But they quickly adjusted to their new home, which they all love! "The girls have made new friends, and I've had the opportunity to make new friends, too."

Haliyah, 4, is in daycare and Lucy, who just turned 5, is in kindergarten. Adorable in their matching Paw Patrol shirts, they sit side by side next to their mom telling a little bit about their day. They both say their daytime activities are "good." Lucy has her coloring book and crayons and is trying to decide which page to color first, showing her mom once the decision is



made. Haliyah has a preschool Big Book of Words. Coming to sit beside you, she identifies everything on the page, from turtles to starfish to tigers. This accomplishment is followed by the question, "Can I have one of all of these?"

Shanikya proudly shares that the girls were part of a Christmas program at North Monroe Baptist. The girls grin and nod their heads, "Yes!" They like the music, Bible stories, and all the children's activities, and they always look forward to Sunday mornings. Shanikya enjoys her time with other single adults. "It helps to have friends who are going through similar things. You get to build on your relationship with the Lord, and you see some who are starting to have that relationship. You get to hear other people's testimonies. Sometimes, you think you have it bad. But hearing others' experiences, it often makes you humble yourself and be more grateful for what you have. It's a good reminder of how blessed I really am."

During their family time, Shanikya and the girls like to watch movies. One of Shanikya's goals is saving for the future and she tries to budget wisely, but she recently treated the girls to a special outing at the mall. "The girls loved riding the bus, and we ate out while we were there. They loved it," she says, as the girls nod in agreement. They are looking forward to more adventures. The campus also offers great places for them to walk and enjoy the outdoors with their campus friends. Shanikya has a part-time job, but she is excited about an upcoming interview for a full-time opportunity. Her short-term goal is to become a pharmacy tech. She has finished the classwork and hopes to begin the clinicals soon. Her long-term goal is to become a pharmacist.

As the threesome heads toward the dining area, the girls give you another round of big smiles and goodbye hugs. Shanikya says that being part of HomePlace Ministry is a huge step toward finding God's plans for her and her family. "Here, they help you reach your goals. They let you take baby steps and get back on your feet. Here, I can learn how to be a better mom for my kids. It's a great place for moms and children."

## Generosity and the Heart of God

### **"For He satisfies the thirsty and fills the hungry with good things." Psalm 107:9**

A few days before Christmas, a young pastor's wife and mother was gathering items for a ministry at her church that helps to feed the needy in their community. Her four-year-old son's attention was focused on his mother wrapping a big cardboard box, hoping he could get involved and help. His mother explained that not everyone in their city had enough of what they need at Christmas, and this is a small way for them to help. So, they started filling the box with cans of soup, bars of soap, breakfast cereal and all the other things that the mom had bought for the occasion. But the four-year-old didn't think this was good enough. He headed straight to the drawer where his mother had stashed all of the sweets he'd been given at parties and birthdays – the drawer from which he was occasionally allowed to pick one treat – and emptied all of them into the box. All of them.

Now, this box was no longer going to be good for anyone's teeth, but it was very good for this mother's heart. It was good to see her little boy moved to such lavish and heartfelt generosity when confronted with a need. He didn't know who would get their box, but he knew that they didn't have enough. He wanted to give of his precious bounty to make their Christmas a happy one.

When I read this story, it pointed me right to the heart of God. Our God is a generous God – not just a give-them-what-they-need kind of God – but a God whose heart overflows with kindness, richness, and a desire to bless. When God gives, He gives the very best. And it is so good—so refreshing, liberating, and challenging—for us to remember that.

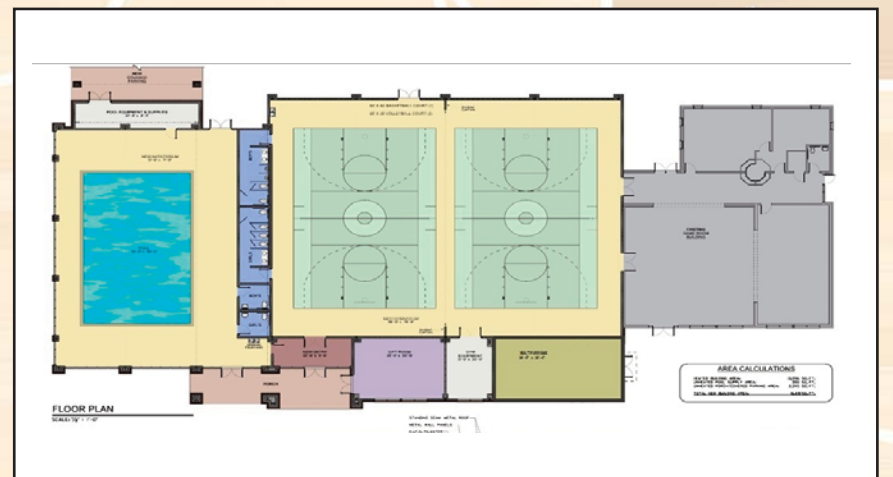

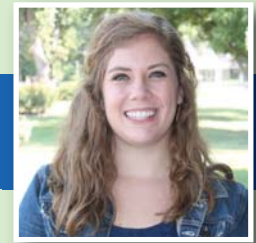

### EVERYONE can be involved in Foster Care...

The biggest need in foster care is always having more families willing to foster! For this reason, our Connect 1:27 specialists hold Foster Parent Informational Meetings in different areas of the state each month. These are the best way to learn about foster care and becoming a foster family. Coming to a meeting is not a commitment, but an opportunity to be introduced to the world of foster care and have your questions answered. We certainly understand that not everyone is called to be a foster parent, but we do believe that everyone can do something!

We know that foster families can be their best when they feel supported. Maybe you don't have a close, personal relationship with a foster family. You do, however, have an opportunity to serve foster families in your area! Across Louisiana, there are roughly 4,700 children in foster care. You may not notice them, but these children are in our own cities, go to the schools in our districts, and live in our neighborhoods. So, what can you do to help a foster family feel more supported? Here are a few ideas:

- Host a Foster Parent's Night Out at your church
- Provide meals to families in your area when they accept new placements
- Collect school supplies to help families prepare for the school year (or replace all of those misplaced pencils and markers as the year goes on)
- Collect backpacks/luggage and items a child could bring to a new placement to feel more at home (such as toiletries, stuffed animals, and pajamas)

- Attend a Foster Parent Info Meeting to learn more about what is involved in being a foster parent to better understand the needs our families have.

- Devote a special Sunday to learning about foster care and adoption in Sunday School—feel free to visit [www.connect127.org](http://www.connect127.org) to find a FREE PDF download to use!

There are many, many ways that individuals and churches can support foster families in their area, and Connect 1:27 is here to help guide you along the way. Contact your local foster care specialist listed above to get started today!

## Granberry Counseling Centers...

### Spiritual Stability in 2019 Requires Sound, Biblical Thinking

“Finally, brethren, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is of good repute, if there is any excellence and if anything worthy of praise, dwell on these things” (Philippians 4:8).

The Bible leaves no doubt that people’s lives are the product of their thoughts. Proverbs 23:7 declares, “For as he thinks within himself, so he is.” A modern counterpart to that proverb is the computer acronym GIGO (Garbage In, Garbage Out). Just as a computer’s output is dependent on the information that is input, so people’s behaviors and emotions are the result of their thinking.

Jesus expressed this truth in Mark 7:20-23, “That which proceeds out of the man, that is what defiles the man. For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed the evil thoughts, fornications, thefts, murders, adulteries, deeds of coveting and wickedness, as well as deceit, sensuality, envy, slander, pride and foolishness. All these evil things proceed from within and defile the man.”

As Christian counselors, we understand that spiritual stability—health and growth in our relationship with Christ and with others—is dependent on consistent, sound, biblical thinking. We often allow our reactive feelings and negative emotions to get in the driver’s seat of our lives and develop unhealthy, distorted thinking. John Stott warned of the danger of Christians living by their feelings: “Indeed, sin has more dangerous effects on our faculty of feeling than on our faculty of thinking, because our opinions are more easily checked and regulated by revealed truth than our experiences” (Your Mind Matters, p. 16).

Paul’s call for biblical thinking is especially relevant in our current culture where there is so much focus on emotion and pragmatism. People no longer ask “Is it true?” but “Does it work?” and “How will it make me feel?”

As Christians, we must discipline our spiritually sensitive minds to think about right spiritual realities. We do this by making quality time with our Lord in His Word and in prayer a consistent, life priority (see Romans 12:1-2).

Jesus’ encounter with Mary and Martha in Luke 10:38-45 is one of my favorite Bible stories. Mary made the tough choice to prioritize “sitting at the feet of Jesus and listening to His word.” She understood that she “did not live by bread alone, but by everything that proceeds out of the mouth of the Lord” (Deuteronomy 8:3). Martha, on the other hand, was “distracted.” Jesus said she was “worried and bothered about so many things.” Martha allowed her reactive feelings and negative emotions to get in the driver’s seat, resulting in conflict with her sister and her Lord.

Martha’s busyness in the kitchen was not bad, it just wasn’t best. Jesus said there was “only one thing essential and Mary had chosen it.” We must not allow anything to distract us from the daily priority of “sitting at the feet of Jesus and listening to His word.” This is where we gain sound, biblical thinking. And our spiritual stability—our health and growth in our relationship with Christ and with others—depends upon it.

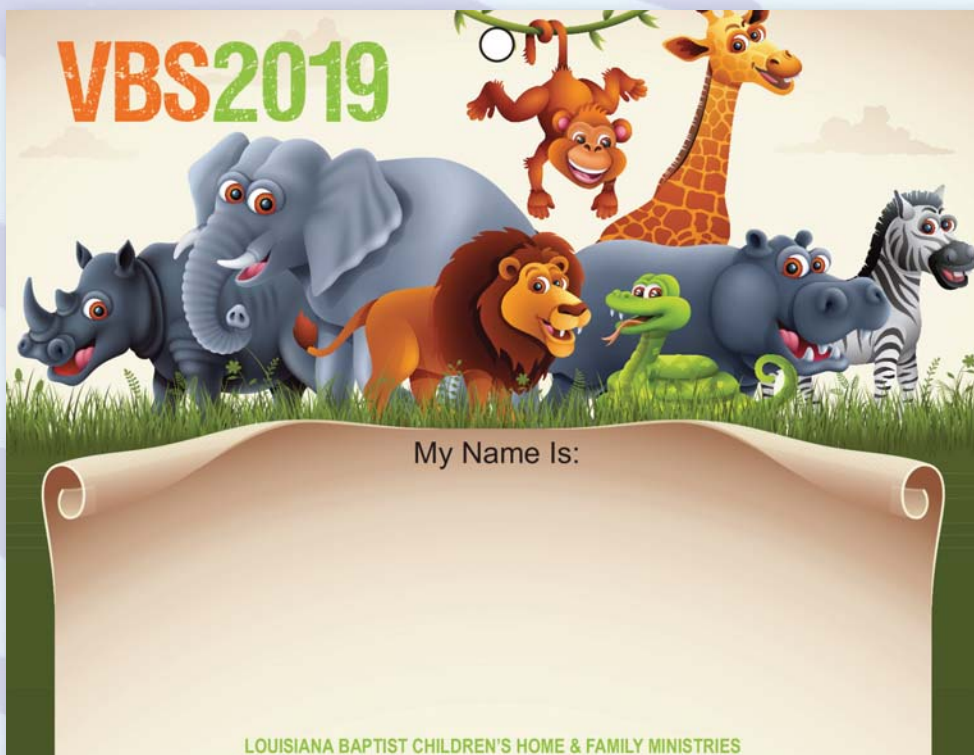

Louisiana Baptist Children's Home & Family Ministries is a faith-based 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization dedicated to providing love, care, and hope in Christ to children and families in need. Established in 1899, the Children's Home is an agency of the Louisiana Baptist Convention and is governed by a 17-member board of trustees elected by the Convention to serve three-year terms on a rotating basis.

The Children's Home is recognized by the Louisiana Department of Children and Family Services (DCFS) as a "Foster Care Community." Approximately 80% of the children in LBCH foster homes are placed by DCFS and the other children are privately placed by a legal guardian.

The Children's Home receives no state or federal funding. Approximately 79% of all funding comes from individuals and churches. Less than 25% of funding goes to administrative costs; 75% goes to direct ministry services. Less than 8% of funding comes from payment of services.

Our major service areas include: Residential Child Care for Children ages 5-17; Pathfinders Transitional Living for ages 18-21; HomePlace Residential Family Care for Homeless Children and Mothers; Christian Women's Job Corps of Monroe providing job and life skills training and certified HiSET preparation and testing; Granberry Counseling Centers with 12 statewide locations; Connect 1:27 Foster Care & Adoption Ministries; and Orphans Embrace International Orphan Care Mission Trips.

Our dedicated Christian ministry team strives to offer the highest quality of services. Services are provided without regard to race, gender, religion, or ability to pay.
